#### Milton Keynes

The Trust has good engagement on this issue and a committed PCT. Some concerns exist about the forthcoming change in DNS / DIPC may leave the Trust without the required leadership

RCA remains the biggest stumbling block to this Trust improving their performance.

The current RCA only goes to a structure level and does not hold people to account

#### Programme Action

RCA retrospective review proposed

Consider the OoC Team

#### Oxford Radcliffe

Performance remains of concern, limited assurance from the Trust about HII and Hand Hygiene. The Trust do not appear to have stepped up their game following January's dreadful performance

#### Programme Actions

OoC Team review 31st March, possible second visit on 10<sup>th</sup> dependent on findings
